

Fronter Training Package

Primary and Special Training B

Please note this model is based on 4 schools working together

This Primary/Special School training package consists of the following 6 elements:

- 1) half day SLT meeting hosted in one of the four schools to discuss the implementation plans for the four schools with the senior leadership teams
- 2) up to three staff attend a school based training day in using Fronter for teaching and learning*
- 3) up to three staff attend a school based training day on Fronter administration*
- 4) two half day visits to each school to follow up issues, provide further guidance and support the embedding of Fronter within the school
- 5) 1 day centrally provided update course in year 2 for a designated member of staff
- 6) access to facilitated Fronter user group sessions which are planned to take place at least twice a year

*It is recommended that the Fronter lead practitioner and Fronter administrator attend both of the courses.

Please note this model assumes the following:

- Elements 1, 2 and 3 of the training programme will be carried out jointly with the other schools
- That elements 1,2,3 of the programme are hosted in one of the schools
- The school hosting the 'hands-on' training in elements 2 and 3 will need to provide ICT facilities with internet connection

For this package, schools may wish to identify a group or cluster of schools they will work with, for example within a confederation. However, if this proves difficult for an individual school then VT Four S will create a training group and discuss with these schools how best to manage this training programme.

Additional Training

Further Fronter support and training will be available to schools at standard traded rates for Surrey schools.
